Metrotile roof tiles are approx. 1/7 of the weight of **traditional heavy clay or concrete tiles.** They are compactly packed, fitting up to 360 tiles on one pallet enough to cover a roof area of about 160 sq. m.

Storm-proof

Natural stone chip-coated rooftile

Overglaze

The final coat to the tile bonds the chip thoroughly to the basecoat, leaving it virtually encapsulated by an acrylic film. This enhances the **attractive "water wet" gloss**, and further increases **resistance to physical damage.**

Stone Chip

The game changer – it makes all the difference. This aesthetic product is the difference between the right metal roof and poor-quality alternatives. Providing 100% chip coverage and tile protection for the product's lifespan, you can buy with confidence.

Basecoat


The chips are bonded to the tile using a super tough polymer acrylic coating (basecoat), which simultaneously protects the underlying layer **from water and UV radiation.**

Steel

Steel forms the heart of the Metrotile tile.
The unique protective layer of Aluminium–
Zinc (55% Aluminium, 43.4% Zinc and 1.6%
Silicon) on the top-quality steel body results in
superior durability and strength.

Transparent Acrylic Coating

The double transparent acrylic coating with a thickness of 1.2 microns provides a uniform substrate that **enhances the adhesion of subsequent topcoats** (basecoat).

Powder coating

Super durable, stylish, scratch and UVresistant 80-micron polyester powder coating preserve the beauty and integrity of the tile surface throughout the entire lifetime.

Polyurethane primer

A special primer that provides additional barrier **protection and corrosion resistance** to the steel core and enhances the adhesion of powder coating.

Zinc-Aluminium-Magnesium alloy

The unique alloy composition of 93.5% Zinc, 3.5% Aluminium and 3% Magnesium provides superior **corrosion resistance** in combination with powder coating.




A durable, rigid, lightweight steel core provides Metrotile painted tiles with **strength**, **rigidity and light weight**.

Providing superior **corrosion resistance** at the underside of the tile

After pressing, this coating and baking process ensures a continuous, even layer and prevents micro-cracking in the bends of steel roof products that are painted first and then pressed or rolled into shape.
